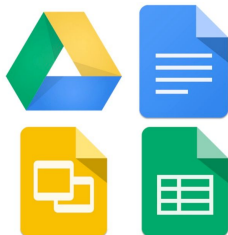

This event is for girls & boys ages 7- tweens!

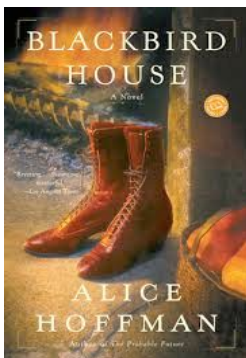
